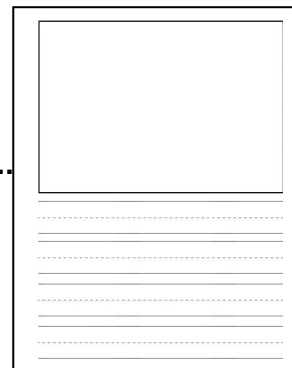


**MA`EMA`E ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST
School Year 2021 - 2022**

1. 1 Backpack - Large enough to fit portfolio
2. 1 Extra set of clothing, in Ziploc bag, **label all clothing with child's name.**
3. 1 Reusable Water Bottle
4. 1 Box Facial Tissue / Kleenex (*large box*)
5. 2 Containers/Packs, Disinfecting Wipes
6. 1 Apron with elastic back (**no ties**)
7. 2 Plastic School Boxes - no larger than 8 ½" x 5 ½"
8. 1 Scissors - child size, blunt tip, stainless steel (*like Fiskars*) **NO** plastic or novelty type
9. 2 Polymer Erasers (*Pentel preferred*)
10. 5 Bottles White Glue (*Elmer's preferred*) 4 oz. size (**NO washable glue please**)
11. 1 3-Ring Binder with View Pocket, **1 ½" capacity**
12. 10 3-Prong Folders with Pockets (*no plastic*)
13. 2 Portfolios
14. 1 **UNRULED** Composition Tablet (no lines)
15. 1 Composition Tablet, **Primary Journal**.....
16. 1 Set WATERCOLOR paints (*Crayola preferred*) Single Palette
17. 1 Craypas (*oil pastels*)
18. 8 DRY ERASE Markers, **Black Broad Tip (NOT Yellow)**
19. 1 Set Classic Color Markers, **Fine Point (Crayola preferred)**
20. 1 Set Classic Color Markers, **Broad Tip (Crayola preferred)**
21. 1 Fine Point, **Black Markers (SHARPIE Preferred)**
22. 1 Ultra Fine Point, **Black Marker (SHARPIE Preferred)**
23. 2 Boxes #2 Pencils with erasers (*12 per box*) **sharpened**, not Husky
24. 3 Boxes Crayons, 24 colors (Crayola preferred) Regular **NOT fluorescent or jumbo**



We recommend **VELCRO FASTENERS** on your child's shoes, instead of shoelaces.

We **highly recommend** that you label all jackets, water bottles & lunch bags with your child's first and last name, so they can be identified and returned if they are lost and found.

* **Label every item** with your child's name in ink (*including every pencil, crayon, craypas & markers*)

* Please **SHARPEN** all pencils.

Every **new** student will be given one free yellow Ma`ema`e T-shirt. Yellow shirts are recommended for field trips.
